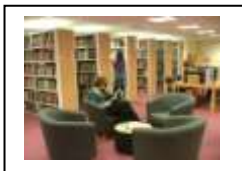

Birmingham Central Library Books

These have now been catalogued in AU's system Voyager/Primo and include: 9 vols of Heinz Kindermanns' *Theatergeschichte Europas*, *Le Theatre Libre* (1890), and *Studi sul teatro contemporaneo* by Adriano Tilgher from 1923.

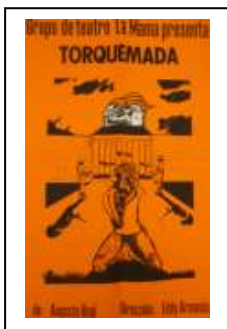
100 boxes!

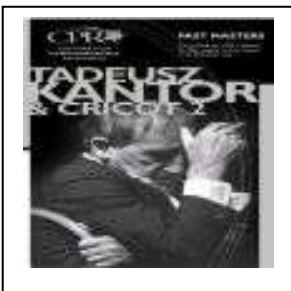
Y Pedwerydd Cyrch
