

Sports Club Code of Conduct 2011/2012

When using the Aberystwyth University Sport Centre facilities Athletic Union Clubs, Digs league clubs students and staff are expected to abide by the following:

- No alcohol to be consumed in or on pitch side of University sports facilities.
- No smoking to be prohibited in or on pitch side of University sports facilities.
- Club committees must ensure that all participants in training sessions are paid up members of the club and hold membership of the University Sport Centre.
- Correct clothing relevant to the sport must be worn at all times during training sessions.
- For events which include participants who are not registered students at Aberystwyth University this code is applicable (eg. Visiting teams + spectators).
- Rude, abusive and aggressive behaviour is not acceptable and will not be tolerated.
- Criminal damage to private and public property will not be tolerated.
- Respect will be shown by club members and staff at all times.

The Athletic Union has the right to withdraw club sessions should club members fail to follow this code.

In situations where a club / society member's behaviour or conduct is a cause for concern the relevant member of staff will report these concerns to the Activities Officer.

In circumstances of disruptive, persistent or behaviour causing significant concerns where the well-being, safety or risk to others is high the decision will be made to withdraw entry/facility to the individual or member. The member will be required to attend a meeting with the Activities Officer.

Complaints made in regard to Criminal Damage and/or Harassment, Discrimination become the subject of the University Disciplinary Procedures following a review by the Activities Officer.
