Terms of Reference:

- 2. To receive information from Faculty Research Committees on matters which affect research-related policies or strategy and to make recommendations on action to Research & Innovation Committee.
- 3. To review applications to, and allocate funds from, University administered funds.
- 4. To review research leave completion reports and analysis relating to the allocation of research leave within Departments / Faculties.
- 5. To receive reports from the Scholarly Communications Working Group.
