

Consumer Protection Regulations relating to Student Admissions - Undergraduate

Under the Consumer Protection Regulations 2000 we are obliged to provide you (the applicant) with certain prescribed information prior to the formation of the Contract. The prescribed information is as follows:-

1. The supplier is the Aberystwyth University.
2. The current Undergraduate Prospectus provides details of the courses of education offered by the supplier. A copy of the current prospectus may be obtained from the Global Marketing and Student Recruitment Office, Cledwyn Building, Aberystwyth University, Penglais Campus, Aberystwyth, Ceredigion, SY23 3DD. Alternatively, e-mail marketing@aber.ac.uk.
3. Please note that educational courses described in the current Undergraduate Prospectus are subject to a continuous process of review and the supplier reserves the right to discontinue or to make changes to the educational courses described at any time.
4. You will have a right to cancel the contract. You may cancel the contract by declining the offer. You may decline the offer at any stage during the admissions process by notifying us in writing.
5. You may defer your entry at any time, subject to approval, up to a maximum of one academic year.
6. The minimum duration of the Contract will be the period of registration required to meet the minimum requirement to qualify for the scheme of study proposed. The period of registration required to meet the minimum requirements will be specified in the offer letter. If the minimum requirements are not met within the period of registration specified, the Contract will come to an end. The normal duration of the scheme of study proposed will be specified in the offer letter.

7. Tuition fees are payable for the educational courses provided by the supplier. Tuition fees become payable when a Contract is formed. The supplier's tuition fees are described on the supplier's website. Please note that tuition fees are subject to review annually and may change.

8. Tuition fees are payable before, or at, registration. The precise arrangements for payment are notified to prospective students in advance of registration. Registration occurs when the relevant academic department and you confirm your registration, thereby agreeing on the details of your study scheme. If your study scheme is more than one year in duration, you will have to re-register with the University at the start of each subsequent academic year.
