

The Gwyneth Evans Bursary
Terms and Conditions
2024 Entry



1. This bursary is open to Undergraduates only
2. Candidates must hold an offer from Aberystwyth University
3. Candidates must be able to provide evidence of living in financial hardship and were either born in Ceredigion or have lived in Ceredigion for the 3 years prior to making an application.
4. The bursary is worth £500 per year of study. Payments will be made in two equal instalments directly to the recipients' bank account. The amounts will be; £250 in December and £250 in March.
5. The Awarding Panel will meet to decide upon the allocations; the decision of the Awarding Panel is final.
6. The bursary may be held along with any other Aberystwyth University Scholarship or Bursary.
7. The successful candidate will be expected to attend all lectures and attain and maintain a high level of academic performance and attendance, as determined by the Awarding Panel.
8. The successful candidate may be required to work with a designated tutor, the University academic departments, and the Development and Alumni Relations Office to promote the bursary and the impact it has had on their studies.
9. Failure to meet any of the above requirements will result in the bursary being withdrawn.
