

## Consumer Protection Regulations

Under the Consumer Protection Regulations 2000 we are obliged to provide you with certain prescribed information prior to the formation of the Contract. The prescribed information is as follows:-

1. The supplier is the Aberystwyth University.
2. The current Postgraduate Prospectus provides details of the courses of education offered by the supplier. A copy of the current prospectus may be obtained from the Postgraduate Admissions Office, AQRO, Cledwyn Building, Aberystwyth University, Penglais Campus, Aberystwyth, Ceredigion, SY23 3DD. 3. Please note that educational courses described in the current Postgraduate Prospectus are subject to a continuous process of review and the supplier reserves the right to discontinue or to make changes to the educational courses described at any time.
4. You will have a right to cancel the contract. You may cancel the contract, by declining the offer. The offer letter will specify the period within which you may exercise your right to cancel the Contract.
5. You may decline the offer at any stage during the admissions process by letting us know in writing.
6. You may defer your entry at any time, subject to approval, up to a maximum of 2 calendar years.
7. The minimum duration of the Contract will be the period of registration required to meet the minimum requirement to qualify for the scheme of study proposed. The period of registration required to meet the minimum requirements will be specified in the offer letter. If the minimum requirements are not met within the period of registration specified the Contract will come to an end. The normal duration of the scheme of study proposed will be specified in the offer letter.
8. Tuition fees are payable for the educational courses provided by the supplier. Tuition fees become payable when a Contract is formed. The supplier's tuition fees are described in the supplier's current Postgraduate Prospectus.

Tuition fees are payable at or before registration. The precise arrangements for payment are notified to prospective students in advance of registration. Registration occurs when both you and the relevant academic department sign your registration form, thereby agreeing on the details of your study scheme. If your study scheme is more than one year in duration, then you will, have to re-register with the University every year each September.

Please note that tuition fees change annually.
