

Getting to Llanbadarn

The Llanbadarn Campus is adjacent to Penglais. The walk takes approximately 15 minutes and the bus journey 5 minutes using current routes and paths. We are working in collaboration with the local council and plans are in development to improve the footpaths and bus service, and to evaluate the feasibility of a cycle path. There will be plenty of car parking for staff and students.

Your Library

The subjects in the Institute will have their own dedicated library based in the Thomas Parry building, at the centre of the Llanbadarn Campus. The Thomas Parry Library will be stocked with all the textbooks, journals, and learning support material you need. You will also have full access to the electronic resources that you rely upon whilst on campus. The library will have extended opening hours so that all resources and the specialist librarians and information scientists will be available to you when you need them.

Easy access to your teaching staff

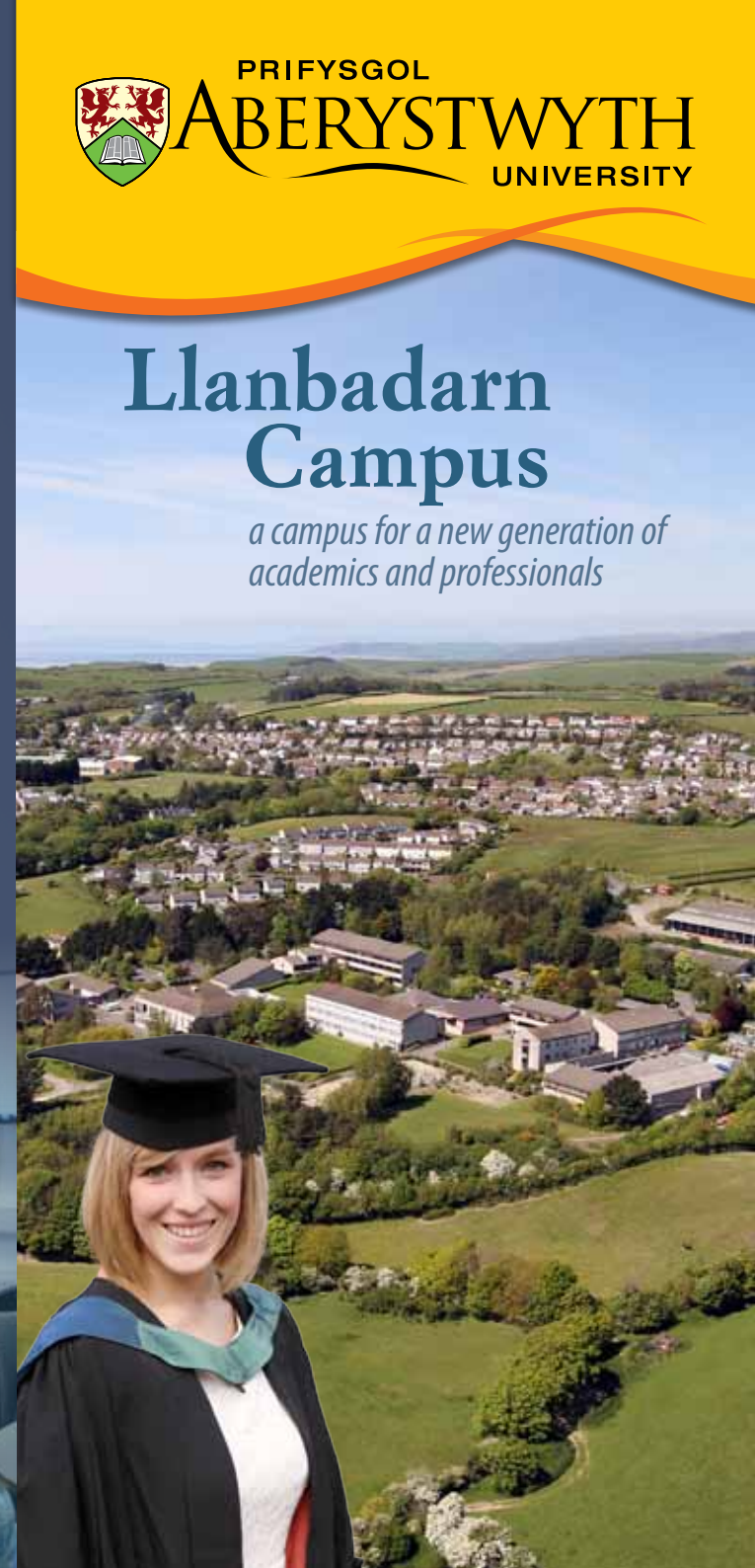

Information for Students and Staff

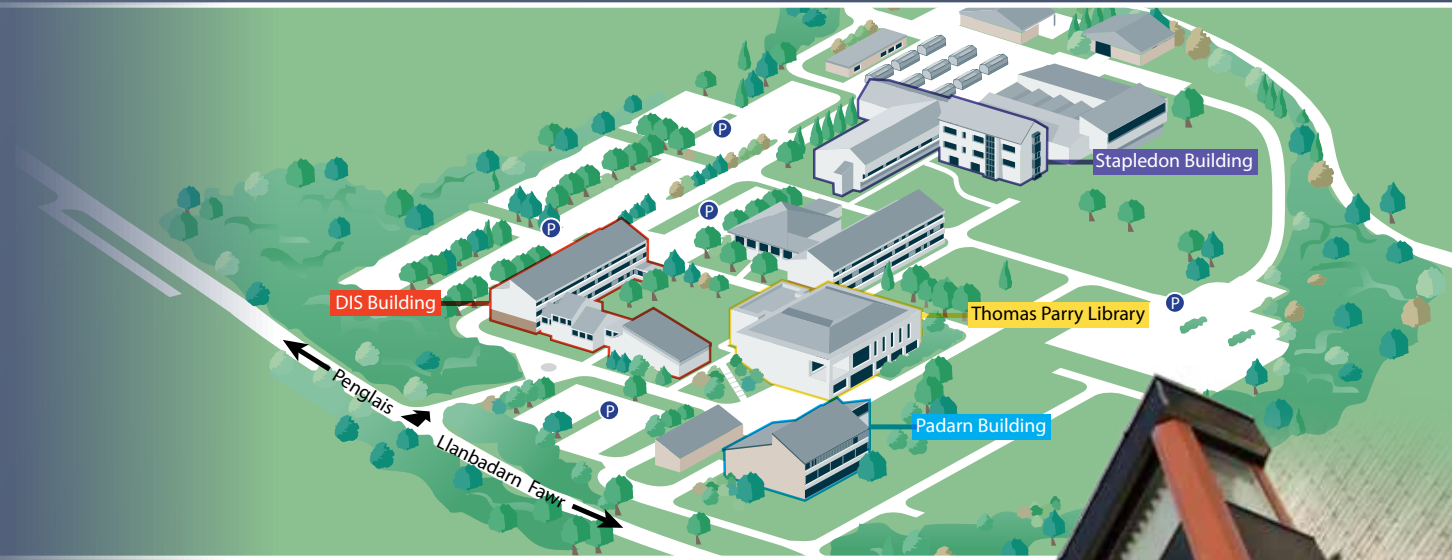
