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ORDINANCE 10

THE COUNCIL: CO-OPTED MEMBERS

1. Co-opted Members

1. Individuals, not being members of staff or students of the University, may be co-opted by the Council as long as the total membership of Council as prescribed by Statute is not exceeded.
2. All co-opted members shall serve for a term of office of up to four years.
3. The Nominations Committee can make recommendations to co-opt members to the Council, but shall first ensure that all vacancies for Independent Members are filled using the procedure prescribed by Ordinance.

2. Eligibility for reappointment

1. A co-opted member may be reappointed, subject to a condition that he/she shall not serve more than eight consecutive years in either that category or in the Independent Members category.
2. When a person has served the maximum permitted period as described in 2.1, he/she shall be ineligible for further appointment in these categories of membership until a period of three years has elapsed.
3. The completion of the maximum permitted period as described in 2.1 shall not make a person ineligible to serve on Council for a further term in another capacity.
4. A co-opted member who is removed from office under Statute 12(2) (a) (iv) shall be eligible for re-appointment after a period of two years.
