Questions:

- 1. What might the West/Europe learn from closer study of Latin American politics and society?
- 2. Why is abortion such a contentious issue in Latin America and what are the prospects for change?
- 3. Does indigenous politics present a radical departure from conventional politics in Latin America?
- 4. Why is the Amazon still being destroyed, despite clear evidence of the climate crisis?
- 5. Either: In what ways does Pinochet's legacy endure in Chile?



Or: What does the struggle over Chile's new constitution tell us about the character of democracy in Chile?

6. Either: Why has it been so hard to tackle the drugs trade in Latin America?

Or: What are the prospects for lasting peace in Colombia? Why has it been so hard to tackle the drugs trade in Latin America?

- 7. How do human rights violations distort politics in Latin America, and how might this impunity be tackled?
- 8. Critically assess what the US-Mexico border represents to those people coming from the south and those residing in the north. What does this tell us about the nature of borders, do you think?
