ENP: history and thinking

2002	 Proposals from British and Swedish Foreign Ministers 'Proximity Europe' (Patten and Solana); 'Everything but the Institutions' (Romano Prodi) + 'backyard of Europe'
2003	- 'Wider Europe— Neighbourhood: A New Framework for Relations with our Eastern and Southern Neighbours'. Russia included
<u>2004</u>	-'European Neighbourhood Policy', STRATEGY PAPER S. Caucasus included
2005	- 7 First Action Plans adopted and 5 more under preparation
2006/7	 - 'Strengthening the European Neighbourhood Policy' - The ENPI enters into force - Neighbourhood Conference in Brussels
<u>2008</u>	-Re-launch of the Union for the Mediterranean (with 9 ENP partners) -12 progress reports
<u>2009</u>	-Launch of Eastern Partnership (6 countries) -Neighbourhood Convention
2010	- Negotiations over Associations Agreements with Ukraine and Moldova
