


- International research project "Russia and the EU" conducted by the Center for Sociological Studies MGU in November 2008.
- The project was initiated and organized by the UK Economic and Social Research Council (grant RES-061-25-0001) under the leadership of Dr. Elena Korosteleva, Aberystwyth University (UK).

- The survey was conducted in the European part of the Russian Federation.
- Method: face-to-face interviews.
- Sample: multi-stage, stratified, random sample reflects the settlement and demographic structure of the RF.
- Sample size: 1503.


What do you associate the EU and CIS with?




Partnership with which countries would be more beneficial for Russia?



Which countries named below have friendly/ adversarial relations with Russia?




Which of the following statements more precisely describe the EU?







To what extent are you interested in what is happening in the EU?




Which of the following values are most attributable to Russia and which to the EU?




How would you define relationships between the EU and Russia?




Do you think the EU is interested in developing closer links with Russia?
