

Funding support available to students studying part-time LLL courses in 2018/2019

Checklist for evaluating the funding support available to you:

1. Are you a continuing student having commenced your studies prior to **1st September 2014**?
If YES go to 2. / If NO go to 5.
2. Do you intend on studying at or above 50% full time equivalent (60 credits or above during 2014/15 Academic Year)?
If YES go to 3. / If NO go to 4.
3. You must first apply for funding through the **Welsh Government's Part-Time Fee Grant Scheme**. Details can be obtained from **Student Finance Wales**:

If you commenced your studies prior to **1st September 2014** and will only be studying up to a maximum of 55 credits within the 2018/19 Academic Year, please complete the **Fee Waiver Application Form**. A successful application must satisfy the Fee Waiver Scheme's eligibility criteria (please see the guidance notes).
5. If you are a new student with the School of Education and Lifelong Learning or if you commenced your studies on or after **1st September 2014**, do you intend on studying at or above 25% full time equivalent (30 credits or above during 2018/19 Academic Year)?
If YES go to 6. / If NO go to 7.
6. If you commenced your studies on or after **1st September 2014** and want to study for 30 credits or more then you are **NOT ELIGIBLE** for a Fee Waiver.
