Campus bus stop. The shuttle bus will drop you at Y Sgubor in Fferm Penglais.

Pantycelyn

(Designated Welsh Medium Accommodation)

To visit this catered, ensuite option for students who want to live through the medium of Welsh, please report to the main entrance at Pantycelyn.

You can walk to Pantycelyn from Penglais Campus, which is located below the Visualisation Centre at the bottom of Pengalis Campus

Pentre Jane Morgan

To visit this selfcatered, shared facilities residence, meet near House 24.

You can walk to Pentre Jane Morgan from Penglais Campus along the marked footpath over the footbridge. Alternatively a shuttle bus service runs frequently throughout the day from Penglais Campus bus stop. The shuttle bus will drop you at Y Sgubor in Fferm Penglais, a short walk from Pentre Jane Morgan.

Living and Studying in Welsh

14:45 - 15:15 - Aber y Gymraeg a Ti (Welsh Medium Reception) - Neuadd Pantycelyn

Here at Aberystwyth University, we are home to a lively, diverse and bilingual academic community, and our Welsh-medium provision is amongst the most extensive in Wales.

We offer opportunities for students who are fluent in Welsh, in addition to those who are less confident or may wish to learn the language. Our range of courses includes those that offer a few modules in Welsh, whilst others can be followed entirely through the medium of Welsh. You can also study modules in Welsh even if you are undertaking your course mainly in English.

As a Welsh-speaking student, you are invited to join the <u>Coleg Cymraeg Cenedlaethol</u>. You can become a member of the Coleg even before starting at the University. One advantage of doing this is you will be allocated a membership number which you will need if applying for one of the Coleg's <u>scholarships</u>.

If you wish to live and study through the medium of Welsh at Aberystwyth, joining Undeb Myfyrwyr Cymraeg Aberystwyth (UMCA) is the best way to experience the close-knit Welsh-speaking community that we have here. UMCA is the first Union of its kind in Wales and has a rich history of community, representation and culture that spans 50 years.

Neuadd Pantycelyn offers accommodation for up to 200 students who wish to live through the medium of Welsh. A five-minute walk from the Penglais campus and town, Pantycelyn is the beating heart of Aberystwyth University's vibrant Welsh-speaking community, open to Welsh-speaking students and those who are looking to learn the Welsh language. Pantycelyn is open to view during the Open Day, with visitors welcome to call in between 9:30 - 16:00.
