Struggling with structure? Worried about making mistakes? Paraphrasing and summarising giving you a headache? Haven't written in Welsh for years? Want to put a shine on your dissertation? Or just not sure where to begin?

No matter your level of study, Aberystwyth University students from the foundation year to PhD level are welcome to use the service.

In one-to-one sessions, Tamsin can help with:

- Structuring your argument
- Writing clearer and more convincing prose
- Rewriting and editing
- Planning and time management
- Tackling the word / time limit
- Critical thinking
- Paraphrasing and summarising (from English or Welsh to Welsh)
- Avoiding common mistakes when writing
- Downloading and using language tools (terms and grammar) on your computer
- Improving your confidence when writing in Welsh

You can choose between a half an hour session or a full hour. Sessions are available on Teams or face-to-face.
