The Emily Price Scholarship Terms & Conditions



- 1. The Emily Price Scholarship is available to a female undergraduate student starting Part 1 of an honour degree to study Mathematics, Physics, or a joint-honours degree in Mathematics/Physics.
- 2. The Awarding Panel will meet to decide upon the allocations in April; the decision of the Awarding Panel is final.
- 3. The value of the Scholarship is £500. The Scholarship is for one year only.
- 4. Where a Scholarship has been awarded, payments are made through Aber Aspire. Students will receive an email notification from Aber Aspire when their funds are ready to access, along with guidance on how to withdraw them.
- 5. It is the award holders' responsibility to withdraw their funds before they expire. Any remaining balance that has not been withdrawn by the specified date will be unavailable, and you will no longer have access to those funds.
- 6. Applicants must not have been a degree student previously at any higher education institution.
- 7. The successful candidate will be expected to attend all lectures and attain and maintain a high level of academic performance and attendance, as determined by the Awarding Panel.
- 8. The Scholarship holder will be required to maintain regular contact with their nominated personal tutor to ensure they are progressing to the best of their ability.
- 9. Unsatisfactory academic progress, or unsatisfactory progress in any of these areas, without good cause, will result in termination of the award.
- 10. Awards are only payable to students studying for a full degree at Aberystwyth (not transferring into years 2 or 3 of the course).
- 11. Payments for students who temporarily withdraw will resume from the start of the next full term in which they recommence their studies (any remaining payment from the term in which they withdrew will not be repaid).
- 12. Please note that if you become indebted to the University, Scholarship and Bursary payments will be withheld and set against any outstanding debt.
- 13. If a student permanently withdraws from their studies before 1 December, the entire first instalment of any award will be reclaimed by the Finance Department. If a student permanently withdraws from their studies between 1 December and 2 March, the entire second instalment of any award will be reclaimed by the Finance Department. Failure to repay any award in such an instance could result in a referral to the University's debt collection agency.
- 14. The information contained in this document is only applicable to applicants who will undertake their studies in Aberystwyth, and does not apply to students studying franchised or validated programmes delivered by our partners.
- 15. Aberystwyth University reserves the right to change or remove any of our current Scholarships, Bursaries and Financial Awards.
- 16. Failure to meet any of the above requirements will result in the Scholarship being withdrawn.
