

Waldo Williams Scholarship Terms and Conditions



1. Applicants must be applying to study full-time or part time for a degree in any undergraduate subject from the Department of Welsh and Celtic Studies at Aberystwyth University.
2. The Bursary is open to first language and second language Welsh speakers, and also to complete beginners.
3. The Awarding Panel will meet to decide upon the allocations; the decision of the Awarding Panel is final.
4. Unsatisfactory academic progress, or unsatisfactory progress in any of these areas, without good cause, will result in termination of the award.
5. Payments for this award are made through Aber Aspire. Students will receive an email notification from Aber Aspire when their funds are ready to access, along with guidance on how to withdraw them.
6. Students deferring their entry will be entitled to receive Scholarships/Bursaries at the level publicised for the year of application (rather than the year of entry in the case of deferred applications).
7. Awards are only payable to students studying for a full degree at Aberystwyth (not transferring into years 2 or 3 of the course).
8. It is the award holders' responsibility to withdraw their funds before they expire. Any remaining balance that has not been withdrawn by the specified date will be unavailable, and you will no longer have access to those funds.
9. Payments for students who temporarily withdraw will resume from the start of the next full term in which they recommence their studies (any remaining payment from the term in which they withdrew will not be repaid).
10. Please note that if you become indebted to the University, Scholarship and Bursary payments will be withheld and set against any outstanding debt.
11. If a student permanently withdraws from their studies before 1 December, the entire first instalment of any award will be reclaimed by the Finance Department. If a student permanently withdraws from their studies between 1 December and 2 March, the entire second instalment of any award will be reclaimed by the Finance Department. Failure to repay any award in such an instance could result in a referral to the University's debt collection agency.
12. The information contained in this document is only applicable to applicants who will undertake their studies in Aberystwyth, and does not apply to students studying franchised or validated programmes delivered by our partners.
13. Failure to meet any of the above requirements will result in the Scholarship being withdrawn.
