What courses are available?

Designed for the aspiring manager considering a career in management or leadership. The Professional MBAs each have a specific focus, enabling you to specialise in a particular discipline.

N1837 MBA Global Supply Chain Management

Focuses on modern global supply chain networks and systems including logistics, green logistics systems and global supply chain systems. You will also learn the latest trends in financial analysis, business economics and leading people and organisations. You will complete a substantial supply chain management report at the end of your studies which is focused on providing value-added improvements within your company.

N1838 MBA Engineering Management

Focuses on engineering systems and the management of engineering and technology-based systems. You will undertake modules in forensic engineering analysis and management, quality systems, project management and supply chain systems. You will complete a substantial engineering management report at the end of your studies which is focused on providing value-added improvements within your company.

N1839 MBA Project Management

Focuses on managing and leading projects and developing and applying the tools and techniques of project management including leading teams, project management techniques and systems, financial analysis, and project monitoring and control. You will complete a substantial project management report at the end of your studies which is focused on providing value-added improvements within your company.

N1840 MBA International Marketing

Provides you with insights and new developments in the area of international marketing including global marketing systems and practice, marketing strategy as well as financial analysis, sustainability and business leadership. You will complete a substantial international marketing report at the end of your studies which is focused on providing value-added improvements within your company.

N1841 MBA Corporate Social Responsibility

Provides you with knowledge of the latest trends in environmental economics, environmental decision making, sustainability and environmental management and combines this work with business-focused work around business finance, leadership and business economics as well as corporate governance and risk analysis. You will complete a substantial CSR report at the end of your studies which is focused on providing value-added improvements within your company.





MBA courses in detail

Overview

MBA Students study full-time over a period of one academic year from September to September.

The emphasis is on learning as much as on teaching. You are encouraged to share your valuable experience in a challenging but supportive learning environment in an action learning style that encourages praxis, the development and use of practical theory. This is further reinforced and complemented by case study analysis.

By the end of the MBA, you will have a more sophisticated and nuanced grasp of business, management and organisations with regard to people, markets, operations and supply chain, economics, corporate governance, ethics, sustainability and strategy. You will also be able to think more strategically and be far better prepared for a career in business and management.

There will be opportunities to network with students from other masters programmes within the Business School. Students will also be offered professional development guidance to help them advance their careers. As postgraduate students of the University, students will have access to the University's Graduate School facilities.

Work Experience Opportunities

Students will also be able to gain valuable work experience by engaging in a number of paid and unpaid internships, and group projects. Paid internships will be limited and dependent on academic performance.

Professional Development

Our MBA graduates have gone on to establish careers in a variety of companies such as Bloomberg, Standard Chartered Bank, Euler Hermes, SAP and Legal & General. Typically, our alumni are senior managers in the public and private sectors or run their own businesses or consultancies.

The reflective and reflexive skills learned on the programme allow students to better evaluate their personal and professional wants and needs, and we find that students are better equipped to plan their careers.

We offer one-to-one professional career guidance, and additional coaching from an accredited 360-degree leadership development coach is also available on request.

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Teaching and Learning

Aberystwyth Business School's teaching staff will create the environment in which practical learning can flourish and facilitate the sharing of experience and knowledge. We know that masters students are extremely busy people, however we expect students to invest time 'outside class' preparing for workshops, researching and writing assignments.

The teaching structure will facilitate critical evaluation and application of theories, concepts and models rather than simple description. The University's virtual learning environment (VLE) will be used to facilitate this process.

Students will be encouraged to use the VLE to help them work independently and in groups, and will be supported academically by module tutors.

Course Details

Students can attend full-time over a period of one academic year (September to September). The academic year is divided into three semesters:

September to January

January to June

June to September.

Assessment is by written report, case study analysis and presentation. There are no formal examinations.

The programmes aim to introduce students to core business and management subjects of finance and leading people, whilst still allowing students to specialise in a particular pathway.

Qualifications or Professional Experience

2:2 Bachelors (Honours) degree, or equivalent, in any discipline. Non-graduates will be considered individually based on relevant work experience or professional qualifications.

English Language Requirements

If you have a Bachelors degree from a UK University, you do not need to take an English proficiency test.

Non-native English speakers who do not meet this requirement must obtain IELTS 6.0 or take a University-recognised test of academic English language proficiency.
