Completing your application

1 > Go to: www.ucas.com/hub

2 > Register

Sign up to check out your options, upcoming opportunities to explore universities and complete your application.

3 > Complete profile

You will have a number of sections to complete. These include:

- > Personal details
- > Education
- > Employment
- > Personal statement



The UCAS system guides you through these and other sections that you will need to complete.

4 > Making an application

You can choose up to five courses*. There is no preferred order and your chosen universities/colleges will not see where else you have applied.

5 > Final check

Take the time to make sure you have completed all sections fully and accurately! Things to consider:

- > Are there any typos?
- > Is the e-mail address you have added suitable and professional?
- > Have you added all relevant qualifications?
- > Are your course choices accurate?
- > Is your academic referee aware of all the good stuff you are saying in your Personal Statement?

6 Final section

- > Your teacher/adviser will write a reference of recommendation.
- Your completed application should be submitted to UCAS with the applicable fee. If you wish to apply for only one course at one institution, a reduced fee applies. The application fee is different if applying for one or multiple courses. Check the UCAS website for the correct amount.



^{*} If applying for medicine, dentistry, veterinary medicine, or veterinary science you can only apply to a maximum of four courses in any one of these subjects.



Tips from Aberystwyth University students on applying

Once you submit your university application, stop reading it! Make a personal statement as unique as possible. Read outside your course. Check university websites to see what skills and qualities they'd like you to have.



Start drafting early.

Don't rush it.

A superb personal statement will not be ready in a couple of hours or even a couple of days. It took me more than a month to complete the version I finally sent in. Sometimes it's worth taking a break for a few days, then coming back to it fresh.

Attend open days.

Personal Statement

The Basics:

- You cannot write more than 4,000 characters or 47 lines of text in a standard font.
- You should write your statement using a word processor, then cut and paste into your UCAS application. Italics, bold and underlined words will not be transferred.



Visit www.sacu-student. com/aber and use the Personal Statement Tool. It's free and will highlight areas for improvement.

The Structure of your Statement:

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First Section (40%) - All about the subject/s you want to study at university Ideas to consider: Why does it interest you?:
What do you want to learn about?:
Your understanding of the course/relevant knowledge:
Current subjects or work experience that relate to the course:

Second Section (35%) - More about the subjects you are currently studying Ideas to consider:

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Third Section (25%) - Your extracurricular interests and achievements
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Some terms explained . . .

Conditional Offer	Details the conditions you will need to meet for entry onto your chosen course (e.g BBB, to include a B in Biology).
Unconditional Offer	An offer of a place of study without conditions.
Firm Choice	Of the offers you've received, this is effectively your preferred choice of course/provider.
Insurance Choice	From the offers received, this would typically be your second preference if you fail to meet the condition of your firm choice.
UCAS Hub	An information and advice platform designed to provide you with all the tools and information you need to explore your options.
	All students will need to register in the UCAS Hub to start an application and then use the same credentials for the entire UCAS application – including tracking offers and decisions.
	Students can sign in to UCAS Hub to check your application's progress at any time.
UCAS Personal ID	When you apply for a place at University through UCAS you will be given a 10 digit UCAS ID number that is unique to you.
Deferred Entry	If you've completed the process of applying to university and you've been accepted onto a course, then decide that you don't want to start in September, you can sometimes defer your course for a year.
