Required Experience

- experience of working with a major Linux distribution (Debian, Ubuntu, RedHat or CentOS);
- experience with agile development techniques;



Familiarity with, or knowledge of, software testing tools such as JMeter and Storyplayer is desirable but not essential.

Personal Qualities

A strong team ethic is essential to our success. We're looking for people who have both individual brilliance and who can work well as part of a team.
